Night To Day

- What a week the disciples of Jesus experienced
 - **John 12:12:13 NIV**, 12 The next day the great crowd that had come for the festival heard that Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem. 13 They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting, “Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the king of Israel!”
 - Can you sense the disciple’s excitement and anticipation

Night To Day

- What a week the disciples of Jesus experienced
 - **Matthew 21:12-14 NIV**, 12 Jesus entered the temple courts and drove out all who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves. 13 “It is written,” he said to them, “‘My house will be called a house of prayer,’ but you are making it ‘a den of robbers.’” 14 The blind and the lame came to him at the temple, and he healed them.
 - “In our face Religious Leaders of Israel”
 - This has got to be the time Jesus takes control of Israel and becomes the Messianic King
 - We were right

Night To Day

- What a week the disciples of Jesus experienced
 - They were so confident - **Luke 22:24 NIV**, “A dispute also arose among them as to which of them was considered to be greatest.”
 - Have you ever read the tea leaves or events of life and made wrong conclusion?
 - Jesus knows there is no way for the disciples to comprehend the coming events, so He had been preparing them for a soft landing
 - **Mark 9:31 NIV**, He said to them, “The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men. They will kill him, and after three days he will rise.” 32 But they did not understand what he meant and were afraid to ask him about it.

Night To Day

- What a week the disciples of Jesus experienced
 - They were so confident - **Luke 22:24 NIV**, “A dispute also arose among them as to which of them was considered to be greatest.”
 - **John 14:28-29 NIV**, 28 “You heard me say, ‘I am going away and I am coming back to you.’ If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I. 29 I have told you now before it happens, so that when it does happen you will believe.”

Night To Day

- What a week the disciples of Jesus experienced
 - Shock and awe come to the disciples
 - The disciples had seen Jesus walk away for many times when people tried to take control of Him, but this time He didn't
 - He seemed to be going willingly
 - They kept looking for the situation to change

Night To Day

- What a week the disciples of Jesus experienced
 - Shock and awe come to the disciples
 - **John 19:16-19 NIV**, So the soldiers took charge of Jesus. 17 Carrying his own cross, he went out to the place of the Skull (which in Aramaic is called Golgotha). 18 There they crucified him, and with him two others—one on each side and Jesus in the middle. 19 Pilate had a notice prepared and fastened to the cross. It read: jesus of nazareth, the king of the jews.
 - Then they hear the words from Jesus that crushed their hearts, minds, every aspect of them personally

Scripture

- Then the disciples hear the words from Jesus that crushed their hearts, minds, every aspect of them personally
 - **John 19:28-30 NIV**, 28 Later, knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, “I am thirsty.” 29 A jar of wine vinegar was there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put the sponge on a stalk of the hyssop plant, and lifted it to Jesus’ lips. 30 When he had received the drink, Jesus said, “It is finished.” With that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

Night To Day

- These were the darkest words heard by the disciples of Jesus, “It is finished”
 - What did they hear?
 - Dream crashing into silence
 - Maybe you have heard these words or thought these thoughts or just overcome
 - Darkness of anxiety and depression so dark that suicide seems to be your only answer
 - Darkness and hurt of loss, death, failure
 - This wasn't just air coming out of their balloons but their balloons exploding leaving pieces spread around on the ground

Night To Day

- The disciples not knowing how to pick up the pieces of their lives just stagger back to the place they were staying
- So, what should the disciples have done during this time? What must we do when these dark times come into our lives?
 - What can we do after are balloons have burst?

Run back to the entire Word of God for clarity

- The work of Satan in our darkness is clear in Scripture
 - **John 12:40 NIV**, “He has blinded their eyes and hardened their hearts, so they can neither see with their eyes, nor understand with their hearts, nor turn—and I would heal them.”
 - **Deuteronomy 4:29-30 NIV**, 29 But if from there you seek the Lord your God, you will find him if you seek him with all your heart and with all your soul. 30 When you are in distress and all these things have happened to you.
 - God’s Word is not just to fill our minds with information but used to attack the blinding and hardness and unturning of dark times

Run back to the entire Word of God for clarity

- How different would it have been for the disciples if they had remembered Jesus' words of rising from the dead
 - How different would it have been if they had remembered **Isaiah 53**, The Suffering Servant
 - How different would this time have been if they had been more interested in what Jesus was saying rather than their position in His Kingdom

Run back to the entire Word of God for clarity

- Even Jesus' last words on the cross speaks volumes to us
- Jesus didn't mean He personally was finish
- He meant the work God the Father sent Him to complete was finished
 - **John 17:4 NIV**, "I have brought you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do."
- "It is finished" – is an accounting term that means "paid in full"
 - What a Jewish merchant would write on a bill owed
 - **John 1:29 NIV**, "The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look (*behold*), the Lamb of God, who takes away (*carries away*) the sin of the world!"

Run back to the entire Word of God for clarity

- Jesus is the ultimate sacrifice that all the other sacrifices pointed to
 - On the cross Jesus sheds his blood to deal once and for all with our sin debt
 - He bore the judgment as the sacrifice for our sins and carries it permanently away
 - Once the bill is paid there is nothing left over to do or accomplish

Run back to the entire Word of God for clarity

- On the cross, Jesus could truly say, “It is finished,”
 - **Hebrews 9:12 NIV**, “He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption.”
- When darkness seeks to overcome you run back to the entire Word Of God and find truth to lead you through
 - Seek the Lord with all your heart and soul and strength

Then we patiently raise up our shield of faith and look for the sunrise

- **Ephesians 6:16 NIV**, In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.
- **Hebrews 12:1-3 NIV**, Let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, 2 fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. 3 Consider him who endured such opposition from sinners, so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.
 - Lift up your head, keep your eyes looking forward for your Heavenly Father has reserved for you joy ahead on the journey
 - **Psalms 24:7-8 NIV**, 7 Lift up your heads, you gates; be lifted up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in. 8 Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle.

Then we patiently raise up our shield of faith and look for the sunrise

- How could Jesus leave the glories of heaven, trust a young couple, be despised and rejected, allow Himself to be nailed on the cross and die, trust His power over death, trust it would all work out
 - He knew His Heavenly Father
 - He trusted His Heavenly Father's word, will, and plan
 - He rejoiced in being able to walk the path given Him, even death
 - He looked ahead at the joy that awaited Him – “for the joy set before Him”

- As a born-again child of God there is always joy set before us if we look for it, believe in it, and seek it out

Sunrises come from unexpected places at unexpected times

- **Luke 24:1-8 NIV**, On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. 2 They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, 3 but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. 4 While they were wondering about this, suddenly two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning stood beside them. 5 In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, “Why do you look for the living among the dead? 6 He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: 7 ‘The Son of Man must be delivered over to the hands of sinners, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.’” 8 Then they remembered his words.
 - The went looking for a dead Jesus and found a risen Savior

Sunrises come from unexpected places at unexpected times

- All the promises of Jesus would be difficult for me to grasp and hold onto if He was still in the tomb
 - How would Jesus be any different than Mohammad or Buddha or any of the other religion founders
- And this is where the disciples thought He still was and would remain
 - They were not expecting their sunrise to be at the tomb
 - God is so much greater than our darkness, but He is also so much greater than our sunrises
 - And it comes at times and in ways and places we least expect
- Two men on the road to Emmaus

Night To Day


- There are other things that were finished that day
 - The power of sin, death and the grave has been crushed
 - The authority of Satan has been stripped
 - The unknown of eternity has been fixed with a place reserved for us
 - No meaning or purpose in our suffering – crushed
 - **Romans 8:18 NIV**, I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.
 - And so many more things making it impossible to list them all
