## 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 3:12-15 NLT

12 Anyone who builds on that foundation may use a variety of materials—gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw. 13 But on the judgment day, fire will reveal what kind of work each builder has done. The fire will show if a person's work has any value. 14 If the work survives, that builder will receive a reward. 15 But if the work is burned up, the builder will suffer great loss. The builder will be saved, but like someone barely escaping through a wall of flames.

- There are two definitions of the word righteousness in the Bible.

- The first definition is that we have now all been made righteous before God the Father as a result of Jesus dying on the cross for all of our sins. The righteousness of Jesus has now been imputed to us.

- The second definition of the word righteousness refers to us living a good and righteous life for God the Father with what time we still have left down here.

- All who eagerly look forward to his appearing
